It is time for us to use our Radical Faith. (If you don't have it, you can't use it.)

**Slide 3.** In the early 1990s, about 90% of US Adults identified as Christians. Today, about 63% identify as Christians. In 2022, 34% of Americans were Protestant. It is estimated by 2070, Christians would make up 46% of the US Population with 41% being secular.

As of 2022, 55% of those ages 18–29 are Christian (down slightly from 58% in 2021), as are 62% of those ages 30–49 (similar to 64% in 2021), 74% of those ages 50–64 (unchanged from 76% in 2021), and 77% of those ages 65 and over (unchanged from 78% in 2021).

**Slide 4.** 7.2% or almost 24 million of 332.4 million are homosexual in 2022. LGBTQIA+ stands for lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer or questioning, intersex, asexual, and more.

<u>Slide 5&6.</u> The Battle has not changed. It is not against the LGBTQ folks. The Battle against Satan and his demons is out of our league. Our primary role is not to fight Satan but seek to deliver those caught up in Satan's elaborate schemes using our strongest weapon, the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Slide 7. [Isa 31:5-7 NKJV] 5 Like birds flying about, So will the LORD of hosts defend Jerusalem. Defending, He will also deliver [it]; Passing over, He will preserve [it]." 6 Return [to Him] against whom the children of Israel have deeply revolted. 7 For in that day every man shall throw away his idols of silver and his idols of gold--sin, which your own hands have made for yourselves.

**Slide 8.** Adrian Rogers: Do you know why so many churches today are filled with people who've never been born again? They have never had a personal faith encounter with Jesus Christ. They've met a creed, but not Christ; they've met a cause, but not Christ; they've met a code, but not Christ; they've met a church, but not Christ.

Do you know Jesus Christ? I want to tell you today that Jesus Christ is real to me. I put my faith in Jesus Christ. This faith is more than something that brings Christ in, it centers on Him. It doesn't simply mention Him or give lip service to Him; **it is all about Him**.

When your life is all about him, you can use your radical faith.

# David Took on a Giant While the Army of Israel Stood By and Watched

**Slide 9.** What he did: Killed a Nine foot giant Philistine who had been taunting Israel.

[1Sa 17:49-51 NKJV] 49 Then David put his hand in his bag and took out a stone; and he slung [it] and struck the Philistine in his forehead, so that the stone sank into his forehead, and he fell on his face to the earth. 50 So David prevailed over the Philistine with a sling and a stone, and struck the Philistine and killed him. But [there was] no sword in the hand of David. 51 Therefore David ran and

stood over the Philistine, took his sword and drew it out of its sheath and killed him, and cut off his head with it. And when the Philistines saw that their champion was dead, they fled.
