

Biblical Correctness - Take a Stand, Be Biblically Correct

Slide 2. [Rom 12:1-2 KJV] 1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, [which is] your reasonable service. 2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what [is] that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

More on Social Correctness

Slide 3. [Gen 1:27 KJV] 27 So God created man in his [own] image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

Moral relativism is the idea that values vary from person to person. **Moral relativism is the idea that there is no universal or absolute set of moral principles.** It's a version of morality that advocates "to each her own," and those who follow it say, "Who am I to judge?"

Slide 4. [Exo 20:12-17 KJV] 12 Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee. 13 Thou shalt not kill. 14 Thou shalt not commit adultery. 15 Thou shalt not steal. 16 Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour. 17 Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that [is] thy neighbour's.

Be Faithful to Church – service, ministry, worship

Slide 5. [Gal 5:13 KJV] 13 For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only [use] not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another.

Slide 6. [Heb 10:25 KJV] 25 Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some [is]; but exhorting [one another]: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

Slide 7. [Jhn 4:24 KJV] 24 God [is] a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship [him] in spirit and in truth.

Everyone has a ministry

Slide 8. [Rom 8:28 KJV] 28 And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to [his] purpose.

Be faithful in the little things as well as the bigger things

Slide 9. [Luk 16:10-12 KJV] 10 He that is faithful in that which is least is faithful also in much: and he that is unjust in the least is unjust also in much. 11 If therefore ye have not been faithful in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true [riches]? 12 And if ye have not been faithful in that which is another man's, who shall give you that which is your own?

Conclusion on Absolute Truth: Be Faithful to your Family – Husbands, Wives, children

Slide 10. [Eph 5:25 KJV] 25 Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it;

Slide 11. [Eph 6:4 KJV] 4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

Slide 11. [Col 3:21 KJV] 21 Fathers, provoke not your children [to anger], lest they be discouraged.

Slide 12. [1Ti 3:11 KJV] 11 Even so [must their] wives [be] grave, not slanderers, sober, faithful in all things.

Slide 13. [Exo 20:12 KJV] 12 Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.
