

Biblical Correctness - Take a Stand, Be Biblically Correct

Slide 2. [Rom 12:1-2 KJV] 1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, [which is] your reasonable service. **2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what [is] that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.**

Slide 3. Absolute truth is a statement that is true at all times and in all places. It is something that is always true no matter what the circumstances. The Bible is full of absolute truth.

Slide 4. Jesus said, [Jhn 15:5 KJV] 5 I am the vine, ye [are] the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing.

Slide 5. [1Pe 4:10 KJV] 10 As every man hath received the gift, [even so] minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

[1Co 4:2, 17 KJV] **2 Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful. ... 17** For this cause have I sent unto you Timotheus, who is my beloved son, and faithful in the Lord, who shall bring you into remembrance of my ways which be in Christ, as I teach every where in every church.

Renew your mind, Be Faithful Because God is faithful

Slide 6. Faithful to His Promises: [1Co 10:13 KJV] 13 There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but **God [is] faithful**, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear [it].

Slide 7. [Heb 10:23 KJV] 23 Let us hold fast the profession of [our] faith without wavering; (for he [is] faithful that promised;)

[1Th 5:24 KJV] 24 Faithful [is] he that calleth you, who also will do [it].

[2Th 3:3 KJV] 3 But the Lord is faithful, who shall stablish you, and keep [you] from evil.

[1Jo 1:9 KJV] **9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us [our] sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.**

Be Faithful to God Choose Biblical Correctness

Slide 8. Challenges: Political Correctness, Social Correctness, The Bible is flawed because it is written by men who are flawed.

Political correctness seems to apply only to those who a person wants to silence.

Slide 9. [Mat 12:34 NKJV] 34 "Brood of vipers! How can you, being evil, speak good things? For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks.

Slide 9. [Mat 23:2-5 KJV] 2 Saying, The scribes and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat: 3 All therefore whatsoever they bid you observe, [that] observe and do; but do not ye after their works: for

they say, and do not. 4 For they bind heavy burdens and grievous to be borne, and lay [them] on men's shoulders; but they [themselves] will not move them with one of their fingers. 5 But all their works they do for to be seen of men: they make broad their phylacteries (a set of small black leather boxes with leather straps containing scrolls of parchment inscribed with verses from the Torah.), and enlarge the borders of their garments,

Social Correctness: Please refer to him as a her because the boy thinks he is a girl. The girl is married to a girl. There is nothing wrong with that.

Slide 10. [Gen 1:27 KJV] 27 So God created man in his [own] image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

Moral relativism is the idea that values vary from person to person. **Moral relativism is the idea that there is no universal or absolute set of moral principles.** It's a version of morality that advocates "to each her own," and those who follow it say, "Who am I to judge?"

Slide 11. [Exo 20:12-17 KJV] 12 Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee. 13 Thou shalt not kill. 14 Thou shalt not commit adultery. 15 Thou shalt not steal. 16 Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour. 17 Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that [is] thy neighbour's.

Attacks on the Bible:

The Bible was written by men, people are imperfect. Therefore the Bible is flawed and not inspired by God.

So you think the Bible must be flawed because people make mistakes?

Yes, that's the way it seems to me.

I'm curious – why do you think there is an exception to that rule?

What do you mean?

Well, you don't seem to think you made a mistake in your judgment about the Bible but you are a flawed human being too.

Of course I am but I didn't mean people always make mistakes.

If people don't always make mistakes, then you can't rule out the Bible being the inspired word of God just because people wrote it, can you?

Slide 12. [Heb 4:12 KJV] 12 For the word of God [is] quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and [is] a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

Slide 13. [2Ti 3:16 KJV] 16 All scripture [is] given by inspiration of God, and [is] profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

Slide 14. [2Pe 1:20 KJV] 20 Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation.

Slide 15. [Jhn 14:6 KJV] 6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

Slide 16. [Jhn 10:10 KJV] 10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have [it] more abundantly.

[Col 1:2 KJV] 2 To the saints and faithful brethren in Christ which are at Colosse: Grace [be] unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

[Gal 5:13 KJV] 13 For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only [use] not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another.

Everyone has a ministry

[Rom 8:28 KJV] 28 And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to [his] purpose.

Be faithful in the little things as well as the bigger things

[Luk 16:10-12 KJV] 10 He that is faithful in that which is least is faithful also in much: and he that is unjust in the least is unjust also in much. 11 If therefore ye have not been faithful in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true [riches]? 12 And if ye have not been faithful in that which is another man's, who shall give you that which is your own?

Conclusion on Absolute Truth: Family – Husbands, Wives, children

[Eph 5:25 KJV] 25 Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it;

[Eph 5:28 KJV] 28 So ought men to love their wives as their own bodies. He that loveth his wife loveth himself. [Eph 5:28 KJV] 28 So ought men to love their wives as their own bodies. He that loveth his wife loveth himself.

[1Ti 3:11 KJV] 11 Even so [must their] wives [be] grave, not slanderers, sober, faithful in all things.

[Mat 19:19 NKJV] 19 'Honor your father and [your] mother,' and, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' "
