Spiritual gifts

Some Christians say, Spiritual Gifts are no longer in operation since the New Testament has been complete.

Slide 3. [1Co 12:1-7 KJV] 1 Now concerning spiritual [gifts], brethren, I would not have you ignorant. 2 Ye know that ye were Gentiles, carried away unto these dumb idols, even as ye were led. 3 Wherefore I give you to understand, that no man speaking by the Spirit of God calleth Jesus accursed: and [that] no man can say that Jesus is the Lord, but by the Holy Ghost. 4 Now there are **diversities** of gifts, but the **same Spirit**. 5 And there are **differences of administrations**, but the **same Lord**. 6 And there are **diversities of operations**, but it is **the same God** which **worketh all in all**. 7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.

Slide 4. [1Co 12:8-14, 18-31 KJV] 8 For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit; 9 To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; 10 To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another [divers] kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues:

Slide 5. [1Co 12:14, 18 KJV] 14 For the body is not one member, but many. ... 18 But now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased him.

Slide 6. 1Cor 14:11 But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will. 12 For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also [is] Christ.

Speaking in Tongues as initial evidence, Glorifying God

Slide 8. [Act 2:4 KJV] 4 And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Slide 8. [Act 10:44-46 KJV] 44 While Peter yet spake these words, the Holy Ghost fell on all them which heard the word. 45 And they of the circumcision which believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because that on the Gentiles also was poured out the gift of the Holy Ghost. 46 For they heard them speak with tongues, and magnify God. Then answered Peter,

Slide 9. (Ephesus) [Act 19:3-6 KJV] 3 And he said unto them, Unto what then were ye baptized? And they said, Unto John's baptism. 4 Then said Paul, John verily baptized with the baptism of repentance, saying unto the people, that they should

believe on him which should come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus. 5 When they heard [this], they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. 6 And when Paul had laid [his] hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied.

Using Spiritual Gifts not for entertainment or human glory

Slide 10. [1Co 14:1-2, 4 KJV] 1 Follow after charity, and desire spiritual [gifts], but rather that ye may prophesy. 2 For he that speaketh in an [unknown] tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth [him]; howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries. ... 4 He that speaketh in an [unknown] tongue edifieth himself; but he that prophesieth edifieth the church.

Slide 11. [1Co 14:26-27 KJV] 26 How is it then, brethren? when ye come together, every one of you hath a psalm, hath a doctrine, hath a tongue, hath a revelation, hath an interpretation. Let all things be done unto edifying. 27 If any man speak in an [unknown] tongue, [let it be] by two, or at the most [by] three, and [that] by course; and let one interpret.

Slide 12.

[1Co 14:5 KJV] 5 I would that ye all spake with tongues, but rather that ye prophesied: for greater [is] he that prophesieth than he that speaketh with tongues, except he interpret, that the church may receive edifying.

Slide 13. [1Pe 4:10 KJV] 10 As every man hath received the gift, [even so] minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

[1Pe 4:10 NLT] 10 God has given each of you a gift from his great variety of spiritual gifts. Use them well to serve one another.

[1Pe 4:10 NIV] 10 Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms.

[1Pe 4:7-11 KJV] 7 But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch unto prayer. 8 And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves: for charity shall cover the multitude of sins. 9 Use hospitality one to another without grudging. 10 As every man hath received the gift, [even so] minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God. 11 If any man speak, [let him speak] as the oracles of God; if any man minister, [let him do it] as of the ability which God giveth: that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever.
