God's Promises depend on God Not Us. Our confidence needs to be in God not our own abilities or anything else.

John Bevere:1994 two-night service at a church conference in Southeastern US. He ministered that first night he preached on the fear of the Lord. On the second night the pastor spent 10 minutes or so correcting John's previous message the night before. The Pastor said the New Testament church does not need to fear God because the perfect Love of God casts out all fear. We have not been given the spirit of fear. He then introduced John to minister. He preached that night and left very confused. The pastor was very old and John was very young. He spent time alone with the Lord and felt as if the Spirit was not against him like the pastor was. Heb. 12:28-29

Slide 27. [Heb 12:28-29 KJV] 28 Wherefore we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear: 29 For our God [is] a consuming fire.
