Open versus Closed

A majority of U.S. adults (72%) are Open in their spirituality. This means approximately 188 million adults are open to exploring and experiencing a deeper life of faith.

The "Nons" Are More Open Than You'd Guess Nonpracticing Christians comprise 45 percent of U.S. adults, and 82 percent are spiritually Open. Even among non-Christians, 46 percent are Open to the spiritual life.

Spiritual Hunger exists: Across generations, 83 percent of Gen Z and Milliennials, 82 percent of Gen X and 79 percent of Boomers say they are certain or think a spiritual / supernatural dimension exists.

Hypocrisy and Science are the leading two causes of doubt. Eyes are on Us All. To rile up his Christian friends, the atheist in the high school class was always looking for scientific speculation that would throw doubt on God or the Bible. Scouring the Internet he discovered research from a student at an obscure university who hypothesized that due to weather and wind patterns, the Red Sea was less than a foot deep when Moses led the Hebrews across it.

"It wasn't even up to their knees," the atheist sneered.

One of the Christian friends exclaimed, "It's a miracle!"

"What miracle?" the atheist asked. "Anybody could have waded across it!"

The Christian grinned. "Simple. God drowned Pharaoh's entire army in less than a foot of water!"

Science always depends on facts and logic to show up their statements, whereas religion depends on people's beliefs and power. Science is focused on developing experiments and observations to solve an answer. Religion addresses the questions that cannot be answered with accurate data.

Spiritually Open: In Search of Peace, The number one thing spiritually Open people seek is inner peace (46%), with hope a close second (41%).

Jesus Matters, Even to Non-Christians One in three Open non-Christians (33%) says they have made a personal commitment to Jesus that is still important to them. What separates Jesus from every other good teacher, leader or religious figure is his resurrection from the dead (1 Corinthians 15:14). Jesus made claims to be divine and fulfilled them by rising from the dead (John 14:16).

They Like Jesus, but Not So Much Christians While they tend to have a warm perspective about Jesus, Open non-Christians are especially critical of his followers—58 percent point to the hypocrisy of religious people as the main reason they're skeptical of Christianity.

Doubts Prevent Openness

Given the widespread openness to the spiritual aspect of life and a collective desire for inner peace, healing and growth, why are so many Americans choosing not to search for their soul's longings within a church context? The answer has a lot to do with people's doubts.
