Amathes - (adjective) - Ignorant or Unlearned

Astēriktos - (adjective) - Unsteadfast, Unstable, unfixed

Strebloo (verb) Wrest – to twist or turn awry. To pervert, as one wrests or tortures language in a false sense.

[2Pe 3:16 NLT] 16 speaking of these things in all of his letters. Some of his comments are hard to understand, and those who are ignorant and unstable have twisted his letters to mean something quite different, just as they do with other parts of Scripture. And this will result in their destruction.

Deconstructing faith is a process of questioning and reexamining one's religious beliefs, practices, and identity.

Two in Five U.S. Christians say they have Deconstructed. Overall, 42 percent of adults say they have deconstructed the faith of their youth. Of today's Christians, it's 37 percent, with little difference whether they're practicing (36%) or nonpracticing (37%) Christians. That means more than one-third of committed, churchgoing Christians relate to the idea of having deconstructed the faith of their youth.

My Servant whom I have chosen, My Beloved in whom My soul is well pleased! I will put My Spirit upon Him, And He will declare justice to the Gentiles. 19 He will not quarrel nor cry out, Nor will anyone hear His voice in the streets. 20 A bruised reed He will not break, And smoking flax He will not quench, Till He sends forth justice to victory; 21 And in His name Gentiles will trust."

The Messiah will put an end to Sin - [Dan 9:24 KJV] 24 Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy.
